The study of freshwater or marine aquatic systems that involve human interaction. Fisheries scientists analyze the ecological health & sustainability of aquatic systems, how the health of fisheries affect people who interact with them and vice versa.

- Participate in resource conservation & management projects with a mentor in your local area
- Gain hands-on work experience in the field and lab
- Learn about career opportunities in the field and courses of study to get there
