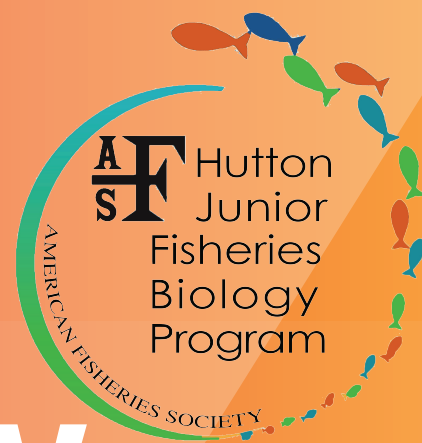


# HUTTON JUNIOR FISHERIES BIOLOGY PROGRAM
